The messages and art will be received by elementary students at Holy Spirit Academy, who Moran said have been taking classes in a community centre following the devastating floods in June.

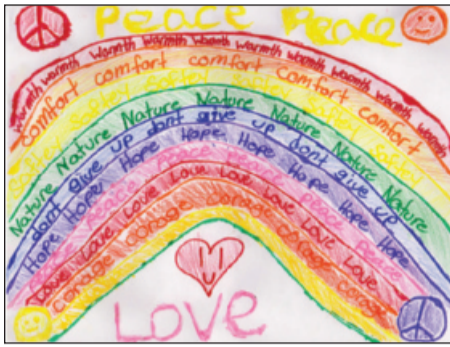
WINTER ART

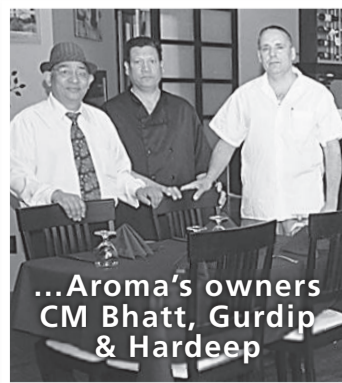
